Question #1:

We have reviewed the Request for Proposals for the Rural Septage Disposal Feasibility Study – Phase 1 for the Regional District of Fraser-Fort George. We were hoping that you could provide the budget for this phase of the project as an addendum so we could adjust our level of effort accordingly in our proposal and determine what is best done as part of Phase 1 and provide recommendations on what can be deferred to subsequent phases.

Please let us know if this is possible.

Answer #1:

The Regional District has not determined a budget for this phase of the project as we have no experience in carrying out such work. We do have a grant of \$100,000 which we are anticipating will carry us through additional project phases should the Regional District decide to continue with additional phases of a feasibility study.

We are thinking of this first phase as a scoping phase as we have no information on septage waste generation and would like for this initial phase to help us understand the scale and cost estimates of treating rural residential septage waste. Our first objective in this phase is to understand waste generation with relative confidence. We then would hope to understand potential options (conceptual) for a centralized treatment facility to treat this volume of waste. We expect that this would include estimates of expected operating and capital costs for the recommended option(s) (Class D cost estimate ranges would be sufficient for this phase of costing). Through this initial phase we would hope to be better positioned to determine what is the future role for the Regional District in providing infrastructure for rural septage disposal and next steps if there is a desire to continue on with the feasibility study.
