Question During the site visit, it was discussed that sloping would conform to WSBC regulations. WSBC does

not specifically prescribe a gradient for machines working on slopes; this is more of a

manufacturer's specification. Can the Regional District specify 1:3 (19 degrees) or 1:2 (26 degrees)

for the final sloping?

Answer Outside slopes will be approximately 2:1 (50%) or (26 degrees), this includes all slopes on

the eastern edge in the identified work area. 3:1 (33%) or (18 degrees) sloping will only be used for areas to be actively filled or filled in the future; this includes all slopes along the

northern edge in the identified work area.

Question Is the regional district adding snow removal as a provisional item to the Schedule of Prices?

Question We could not find a specification for depth of cover; what does the Regional District want to see for

depth of cover on the garbage?

Answer Cover will be applied at a depth of 30cm. See meeting minutes.
