Addendum No. 2

**Request for Proposals ES-23-24
Cell Two Logging
Foothills Boulevard Regional Landfill**

The addendum is being issued prior to the closing of the Request for Proposals to provide further information, make changes to, or to clarify the Contract Documents and is to be read, interpreted and coordinated with all other parts of the Contract Documents. In the case of a conflict with the balance of the documents, this Addendum shall govern. **Proponents shall attach a signed copy of this addendum to their proposal.** This addendum shall form part of the Contract Documents.

This addendum is being provided in clarification to RFP ES-23-24 released November 10, 2023

Statement correction below (bolded) to clarify this Addendum No.2

Question 1: "5.0 Scope of work is to log all harvestable trees and remove the same from the site."
Is the term harvestable, used in the RFP, the same as merchantable? The cruise data is based on merchantable volumes, which can potentially be marketed.

Answer 1: Harvestable timber is all timber to be felled, as explained at the mandatory site viewing. Merchantable volume represents all stems defined as merchantable volumes to be marketed.

Question 2: There is currently no market or home for the deciduous volume. Can the contractor leave the stand, for example, in the Type II area shown on the cruise map? Or are they required to harvest and pile this material and make it available for the upcoming grinding contract?

Answer 2: Potential markets for all species have been located. In the absence of this, the requirement is that all deciduous stems be felled and piled as per RFP. The expectation is for all merchantable timber to be harvested and removed from the site.

Question 3: Can the proponent make arrangements for a site visit with their sub-contractors prior to the closing date and time? No escort is needed by RDIFFG.

Answer 3: As per Section 2.3, The Regional District will not, under any circumstances, make accommodations for rescheduling, holding any additional site meetings or providing individuals access to the sites.
