### Addendum No. 1

#### Invitation to Tender ES-26-01 Construction Services - Final Closure Valemount Regional Landfill

The addendum is being issued prior to the closing of the Invitation to Tender to provide further information, make changes to, or to clarify the Contract Documents and is to be read, interpreted and coordinated with all other parts of the Contract Documents. In the case of a conflict with the balance of the documents, this Addendum shall govern. **Tenderers shall attach a signed copy of this addendum to their submission.** This addendum shall form part of the Contract Documents.

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This addendum is being provided in clarification to ITT ES-26-01 released February 23, 2026.

**Question 1: Due to the changes to WorkSafeBC Occupational First Aid regulations effective November 2024, which may require increased levels of first aid attendants and dedicated emergency transportation vehicles (ETVs), please clarify how first aid coverage is intended to be provided for this project.**

**Specifically, will the Owner/Prime Contractor provide project-wide first aid coverage, or will each contractor be expected to supply first aid attendants, equipment, and emergency transportation for their workforce?**

Answer 1: Project wide first aid coverage will be the responsibility of the successful Tenderer.

**Question 2: We request that a Digitally Verifiable Bid Bond be accepted as an alternate submission format for the Bid Bond submission and that it be submitted via email along with the digital Tender Submission.**

Answer 2: **Page 4 of ITT ES-26-01 states:** The Bid Bond must not be sent by email. The Bid Bond must be received by the General Manager of Financial Services, at the Regional District of Fraser-Fort George, 3<sup>rd</sup> Floor, 155 George Street, Prince George, BC on or before the Closing Date. The Bid Bond must be submitted in a sealed envelope with the following information written on the outside of the envelope containing the Bid Bond, as well as on the outside of the Courier envelope if being sent by courier.

**Question 3: Will the list of attendees and their contract information be distributed with the meeting minutes?**

Answer 3: Only the names of companies in attendance at the mandatory site meeting will be included within the meeting minutes.

**Question 4: Will the successful proponent need to have a bird survey conducted for the standing trees at the landfill?**

Answer 4: All remaining standing vegetation within the work area will be removed prior to the commencement of the project. It will be the responsibility of the successful proponent to determine whether a bird survey is necessary prior to the removal of the remaining vegetation.

**Question 5: Will standing trees on the landfill footprint be removed prior to the start of the nesting season?**

Answer 5: All remaining standing vegetation within the work area will be removed prior to the commencement of the project.

**Question 6: What type of material will be moved off-site for item K01 Disposal Off-Site?**

Answer 6: Construction materials that would be landfilled or recycled and which would not remain on site after completion of construction activities. Disposal of these materials is permissible at the Valemount Regional Transfer Station - applicable transfer station tipping fees apply.

**Question 7: Will the grubbing material be chipped?**

Answer 7: No, grubbing material will not be chipped. Existing standing vegetation in the landfill cover area will be removed by OWNER prior to construction activities and bird nesting.

**Question 8: Will the perimeter ditch on the north side of the landfill be on the north or south side of the fence?**

Answer 8: Ditch will be a field fit on the south side of the fenceline between the edge of landfill cover area and fenceline. Placement of ditch will be coordinated on site with ENGINEER/OWNER.
