Invitation to Tender ES-26-11 Compaction and Cover Services – Mackenzie Select Waste Landfill

The addendum is being issued prior to the closing of the Invitation to Tender to provide further information, make changes to, or to clarify the Contract Documents and is to be read, interpreted and coordinated with all other parts of the Contract Documents. In the case of a conflict with the balance of the documents, this Addendum shall govern. **Tenderers shall attach a signed copy of this addendum to their submission.** This addendum shall form part of the Contract Documents.

This addendum is being provided in clarification to ITT ES-26-11 released April 15, 2026.

Question 1: Could you please clarify what the quoted hourly rate includes? Specifically, should the hourly rate include all the equipment and personnel to complete the cover and compaction or is the intent that each piece of equipment be priced separately ?

Answer: The hourly rate includes whatever resources are required to complete the work in accordance with the contract including all equipment and personnel required to complete the cover and compaction services.

Question 2: Can you please confirm if there is a provision for annual fuel rate adjustments if/ when the fuel costs increase?

Answer: A Fuel Surcharge Table will be added to this tender as a mechanism to adjust for fluctuating fuel prices. See below.

Add Fuel Surcharge to Part C, Contract Conditions as Section 34 and shall now read:

34 Fuel Surcharge

A Fuel Surcharge Rate Adjustment Scale will be implemented. The following table demonstrates the applicable fuel surcharge rate that can be applied to the tendered unit price each month for the **hauling portion only**. The reference index will be Natural Resources Canada's Petroleum Product Prices publication for diesel prices in Prince George which can be viewed at <https://natural-resources.canada.ca/domestic-international-markets/diesel-prices>.

The applicable fuel surcharge will be determined monthly and the month's applicable fuel surcharge rate will be based on the fuel index price for the first day of the month for Prince

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George. The price of \$2.031 per litre for diesel (as of April 24, 2026) will be used as a starting point for Contract ES-26-11. For example, if the index reports a price of \$1.865 on August 1, the fuel surcharge payable for the tendered unit price for the month of August will be decreased by -1.00%. If on August 1, the price is reported at \$2.180, then the Fuel Surcharge for the tendered unit price in August will be increased by +1.00%.
