## **Addendum No. 2**

### **Request for Proposals ES-24-02 Engineering Consulting Services - 2024 Well Field Review and Expansion Foothills Boulevard Regional Landfill**

The addendum is being issued prior to the closing of the Request for Proposals to provide further information, make changes to, or to clarify the Contract Documents and is to be read, interpreted and coordinated with all other parts of the Contract Documents. In the case of a conflict with the balance of the documents, this Addendum shall govern. **Proponents shall attach a signed copy of this addendum to their proposal.** This addendum shall form part of the Contract Documents.

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This addendum is being provided in clarification to RFP ES-24-02 released January 10, 2024

Question 1: With the extension of the closing date to February 2, 2024, is there an extension for requests for clarification or inquiries? or will that still be January 22, 2024?

Answer 1: With the extension of the closing date to February 2, 2024, the requests for clarification or inquiries will be extended to Thursday, January 25, 2024 at 3 pm Pacific Standard Time.

Question 2: Can the RDIFFG provide us with an approximate number of wells that are anticipated to be installed or the size of the area for the 2024 expansion, so we can determine the amount of time required for on-site supervision? This information is also required in order to determine costing for the 2024 landfill gas wellfield expansion detailed design work.

Answer 2: Please find attached. Figures - FOOTHILLS - INFRASTRUCTURE Showing Work Area.

Question 3: Sometimes, the presence of the on-site construction supervision can depend on the competency and experience of the construction contractor. Is it the RDIFFG's intention that the proponent should assume that full-time on-site construction supervision is required?

















Answer 3: The level of construction oversight (outside of the items identified in the RFP) required shall be determined by the Proponent. The successful proponent will be expected to provide services in accordance with a standard of care, skill and diligence maintained by a person (or firm) providing the services described herein.

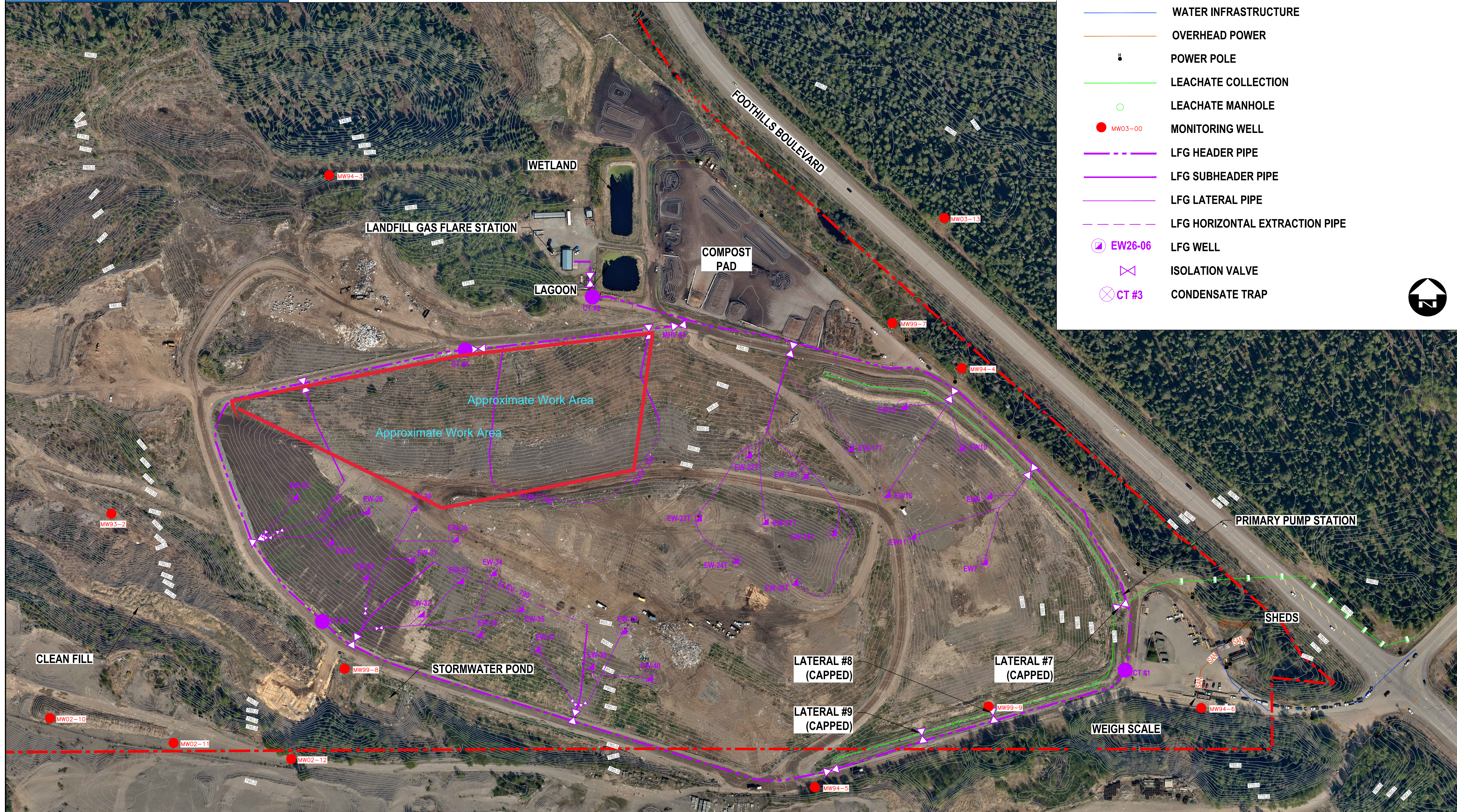
Question 4: In order to cost out a high level design for the entire area of Cell 1, we require a site plan that shows the cell delineations. Can this be provided?
