



ASBESTOS CONTROLLED WASTE DISPOSAL

The Foothills Boulevard Regional Landfill (FBRL) is authorized under the [Environmental Management Act](#), through *Operational Certificate MR-01697*, to receive waste for disposal including controlled waste, which is defined as material requiring additional or special handling when tipped at the landfill. Some controlled waste is also hazardous waste, such as asbestos. The Regional District of Fraser-Fort George (RDFFG) may accept waste asbestos from industrial, institutional, commercial, and residential sources.

Waste asbestos is defined in the [Hazardous Waste Regulation](#) (Regulation) as a waste containing friable asbestos fibers or asbestos dust in a concentration greater than 1% by weight either at the time of manufacture, or as determined using a method specified in [Section 40\(1\)](#) of the Regulation. As it is a hazardous waste, asbestos requires specific techniques for safe handling, transport, and disposal.

This application applies to the disposal of friable and non-friable waste asbestos from within the boundaries of the RDFFG.

Allow up to two (2) business days for review and response to application.

Waste asbestos disposal will be scheduled on
Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday between 9:00AM – 1:00PM.

Requirements and restrictions for disposal of asbestos:

- The carrier must have a License to Transport waste asbestos if over 5 kilograms, unless exempt under the Regulation (i.e., homeowners, farmers, or waste asbestos owner using a vehicle registered under their name and transporting less than 1000 kilograms).
- A [Generator Number* \(BCG#\)](#) must be obtained, unless exempt under the Regulation (i.e., generates or stores less than 1000 kilograms of waste asbestos on site).
- The carrier must have a Manifest issued by the province of BC, unless exempt under the Regulation (i.e., homeowners and farmers).
- Waste asbestos must be packaged or contained using appropriate techniques that comply with the Regulation, [Section 40\(2\)\(b\)](#) (e.g., two 6-mil poly asbestos bags, individually sealed).
- Waste asbestos contained and transported in bladder bags will not be accepted.
- Asbestos containing items and materials with a volume greater than 1.5 cubic meters and 2.5 meters in length are classified as "Bulky Waste" and will be charged for accordingly.
- Carrier must unload contained waste asbestos by hand.
- Carrier must wear appropriate Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) as per [WorkSafeBC](#) when unloading waste asbestos.
- Carrier's transport bins must not exceed 20-yard³ in volume, and 6500 kilograms in weight.
- Loads of asbestos must be within +/- 5% of Permit/Manifest weight, per the Regulation, [Section 5\(4\)](#).
- Asbestos loads over +5% of the approved Permit weight will be subject to additional fees (may come into enforcement during the 2025 calendar year).

Regional District of Fraser Fort George employees will escort and inspect all loads to ensure compliance and are NOT responsible for unloading waste asbestos.

**Per the "Hazardous Waste Regulation" [s.43(1)], a person, partnership or company in B.C. must register as a Generator of hazardous waste and obtain a Generator number (BCG#) if they produce and or store on the generating site more than 1000kg of waste asbestos at any given time within a 30-day period. This applies regardless of the source (i.e., residential, industrial, commercial, or institutional).*
