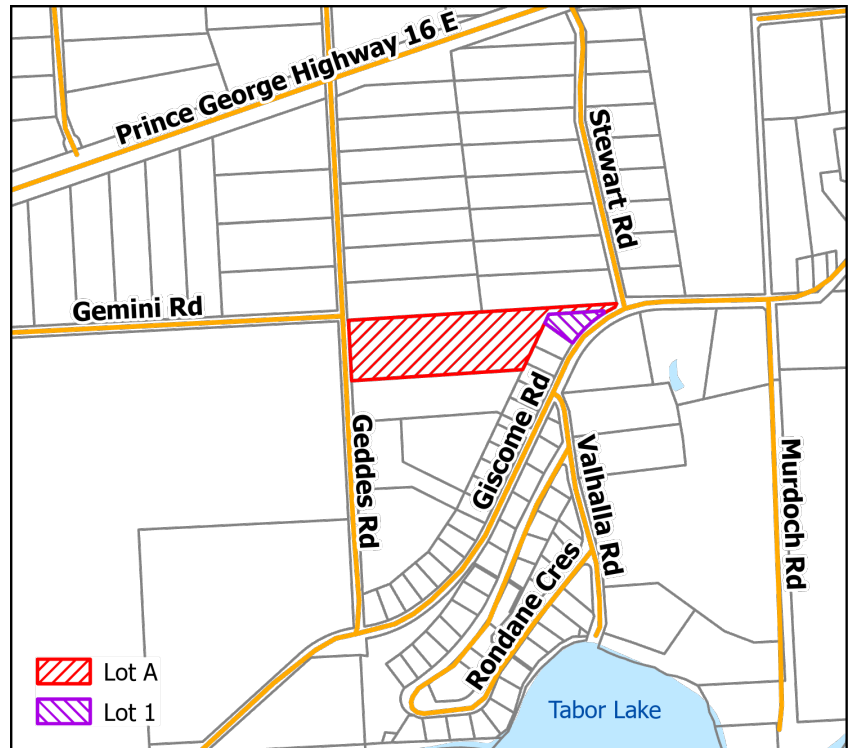

Proposal: Development Variance Permit No. 1519 is proposed to vary Section 3.0 and 4.0 of Regional District of Fraser-Fort George Subdivision Servicing Bylaw No. 2815, 2013, by waiving the drinking water and sewage system requirements for a boundary adjustment subdivision transferring 0.15 hectares of land from Lot A to Lot 1.
