Proposal: An application has been made for a Zoning Bylaw amendment to allow Riding Stable use to be established on the subject property.

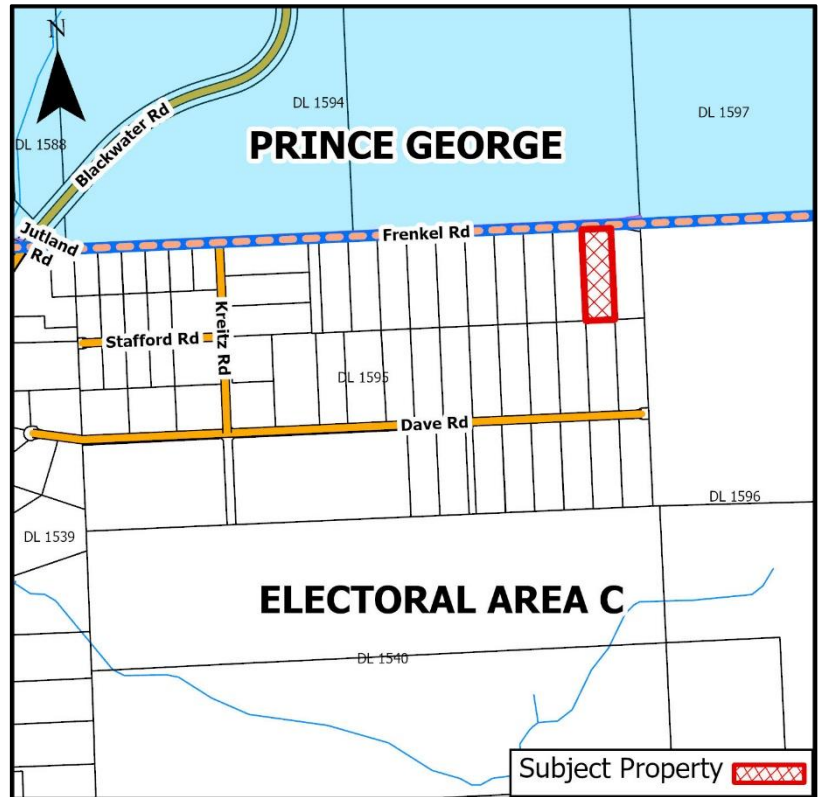
